Gloves

prevent spreading bacteria when tending wounds



Water Bottle

can reduce body temperature and flush wounds



Tweezers

or forceps to remove foreign bodies and sharp objects



Bandaging

non-stick pads, gauze, and adhesive tape control bleeding



Antiseptic

sterilizes wounds to prevent bacterial infection



Benadryl

treats allergic reactions at vet's instruction



Hydrogen Peroxide

induces vomiting at vet's instruction



Muzzle

allows for safe first aid and transport



E-Collar

prevents pets from agitating wound

local contact info and poison control helpline

Pet First Aid Tips

- Apply pressure to bleeding
- Restrict pet's movement
- Call ahead on the way to ER
