The Happy Snowman Vase is here to sleigh your holiday décor game! Made from plywood and acrylic, this jolly little guy holds your flowers and your festive spirit like a pro. Who needs boring vases when you can have one that literally gives you all the holiday cheer?

With your Glowforge, cut out the base vase and snowman plates using light Proofgrade plywood. Using your choice of Eco Thin Proofgrade acrylic colors, cut out the eyes, mouth, nose, cheeks, buttons, and scarf.

Snap together the inner box pieces. The smallest piece is the bottom, and the longer pieces snap vertically on each side. (If necessary, use a mallet to gently tap the pieces together.)

Insert the box's long cut into one of the base vase plates. (If necessary, use a mallet to gently tap the pieces together.) Repeat with the additional base plate.

Spray paint the front and back snowman plates white. Allow to dry fully. Adhere these pieces to the base vase using super glue. Line up the acrylic pieces with the scored lines. Adhere with super glue. Once dry, flip the vase over and adhere the back scarf piece. Name your snowman and enjoy!
