Gather your supplies: 1/8" material (Bail used Proofgrade Light Cherry Plywood), 4mm cotton macrame cord (neutral for gifting), a macrame brush, and scissors.

Format your coasters in the Glowforge App. Make sure you set the design to "Cut", then, when you're ready, hit the glowing button! Cut out your coasters. If you're creating a gift set, consider cutting 4 to 6 coasters for each set.

Once cut, remove the masking. Then, cut thirty 7-inch strands of macrame cord. Using 5 strands of cord for each slot on the coaster, begin tying Lark's Head knots around the edge. Continue around the entire circle.

With a macrame brush, gently brush out the strands for a softer look. Trim the ends of the strands evenly to complete your coasters.
