Gather your materials (Dani chose Red Eco Thin Acrylic), glue, paint, paintbrushes, a thin sheet of clear plastic (to act as a pane for the frame), and, most importantly, your concert memorabilia!

Format and personalize the design in the Glowforge app. Here, you can engrave the show dates, hide Easter eggs, and choose whether to use the hook system for hanging friendship bracelets. Cut and Engrave!

Paint over any engravings before removing the protective layer. Assemble and glue together the acrylic pieces of the shadow box. Hint: the piece with long slots sits freely at the bottom of the box to display polaroids and concert tickets!

Fill your shadow box with friendship bracelets, confetti, photos, memories, pieces of costumes, and insert the optional hooks into the holes in the back of the box to hang wristbands and lanyards! Close up the box by sliding in the clear pane (or skip this step if you want easy access to your trinkets!) 1
