Use This in Encourage:

- Review their saved or matched careers to explore:
 - · Education/training needed
 - How it connects to interests or current classes



Suggested Follow-Up

"Let's look at one of your saved careers together. Does it feel like a good fit? What would it take to get there?"



Self-confidence in ability to succeed (M4)



Use This in Encourage:

- Go to My Students → Student Name → Career Goal + Educational Pathway Goals
- Open the Majors & Careers tab to explore:
 - Matched results from the Majors & Career Quiz
 - · Saved majors and careers the student has explored



Suggested Follow-Up

"What stands out to you in your saved results? Do they match your strengths or interests?"

ASCA Standard

Identify long- and short-term academic, career, and social/emotional goals (B-LS7)

Ask This: "What are some of your goals this year and beyond?"

Use This in Encourage:

- Within Encourage, **My Journey** provides grade-by-grade task lists to guide students through key planning moments.
- Each task includes clear steps, space for reflection and helpful resources like checklists or videos.



Suggested Follow-Up

"Let's take a lot at your tasks in **My Journey**. Which ones can you tackle in the next two weeks to bring you closer to your next step?"






How Encourage Can Support 1:1 Counseling Meetings



Demonstrate perseverance to achieve long- and short-term goals (B-SMS5)



Use This in Encourage:

- Go to My Students → student name
- In their profile, you'll see their:
 - Career goal
 - Educational pathway goal
 - Planned field of study
- Use these goals as starting point to explore whether their current choices are aligned with that they want for their futures.

Suggested Follow-Up

"I see you have shared some goals in Encourage. Let's discuss how those line up with what you are doing now. Are your classes, activities, or college ideas helping you get closer to your path?"
