

Roll Up Door Lockbox Installation

Procedure:

Safety Precautions:

- Wear appropriate protective gear, including a welding helmet and gloves.
- Ensure proper ventilation in the work area.
- Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

Prepare the Work Area:

- Clean the area on the roll-up door where the lock box will be installed.
- Use an angle grinder to remove any rust, paint, or debris from the welding area.
