On average, households receive 46 landline calls every week


Of these 46 weekly calls, 40 are unwanted

Monthly increase in landline call volume





#### **Report Methodology**

- <sup>1</sup> The Center for Disease Control surveyed 14,629 households for the period June to December of 2021. The CDC gathers data on landline and cellphone penetration. Their data, when applied to the US Census Estimates of 140.6 million total households in 2022, equates to a total of 39.5 million households having a landline and a cell phone.
- <sup>2</sup> imp<sup>™</sup> insights are based on in depth analysis of 100 users and data through 9.30.22. Extrapolating these findings to a potential market of 39.5 million households with landlines, this data has a 90% confidence level with a margin of error of less than 10%
- <sup>3</sup> Landline phone survey October 10, 2019, among 502 U.S. adults
- <sup>4</sup> Data based on analysis of 20,900 U.S. adults from January 1, 2022 September 30, 2022
