#### **CHALLENGE**

### Manual Tipping System Challenges:

Stoney's Bar & Grill struggled with a complex, **time-consuming manual tipping system**, leading to calculation errors and financial discrepancies.

#### **Human Error and Administrative Burdens:**

Human error in the manual process caused overpayments or underpayments, creating **tension** and **administrative burdens**, while the lack of transparency fostered staff distrust and **potential legal liability**.
