Review your homeowners insurance coverage for any potential gaps.

Store pool chemicals in a cool, dry, and secure location to avoid ingestion, inhalation, or skin contact.

Remove floats and toys after swimming.

Establish and share swimming pool safety rules for home residents and guests.

Always supervise children near the pool, regardless of their swimming ability.

**MEDIUM
EFFORT**

Prepare for a pool-related emergency with a first aid kit, flotation devices, and regular safety checks.

Consider swimming lessons for the whole family.

Maintain the pool deck and surrounding areas with regular cleaning, inspections, and occasional repairs.

Purchase and inspect pool safety equipment, like a safety gate, cover, alarm, rescue flotation device, etc.

Install a pool safety fence or other barriers to separate the pool area from the rest of the yard.

Install anti-entrapment drain covers and a safety release system with the help of a professional.
