BEFORE THE STORM
Assess your risk. Understand your home and area's hurricane vulnerability.
☐ Create an evacuation plan. Choose escape routes, locate shelters, and practice your plan.
Assemble a preparedness kit. Gather essentials like food, water, first aid supplies, and personal items.
Inventory your home. Document belongings and review insurance coverage.
Help prevent flooding. Consider adding flood insurance, installing flood barriers, and waterproofing your home.
Regularly inspect your home. Complete maintenance on your roof, gutters, windows, and secure outdoor items.
DURING THE STORM
Secure your home. Close and secure windows and doors, unplug electronics, and move valuables to higher ground.

☐ Inspect your home. Assess for damage, take photos, and document any injuries.
Contact your insurance company. File a claim for covered damages.
Seek professional help. If you filed a claim, your insurance provider will work with you to complete repairs through a certified professional.
