# Call for Artists: "Beat Box" Funded by Denver Arts and Venues' "P.S. You Are Here" Grant Program

Showcasing Colorado's Vibrant Past and Present Music Scene

**Denver, CO** – Rocky Mountain Public Media is getting ready to paint the town! "Beat Box", a community art project led by KUVO Jazz and THE DROP 104.7 radio stations, is looking for artists.

"Beat Box" aims to showcase Colorado's vibrant past and present music scene and elevate local artists through the creation of six utility box murals near the Buell Public Media Center (home to Rocky Mountain Public Media, the parent organization of KUVO Jazz and THE DROP 104.7 radio stations) in downtown Denver. Each mural will feature the portrait of a prominent historical or active Colorado musician to raise public awareness about their artistic contributions and enhance community pride. "I'm grateful to be acknowledged in the city like this after 10 years of putting in work!" says one of the musicians selected by KUVO Jazz and THE DROP 104.7 listeners.

"Colorado has one of the most vibrant and creative music scenes in the nation, and this mural project is a powerful tribute to that legacy. "Beat Box" was created to honor not only the sound of our city but its soul — jazz and hip-hop — two sounds born from struggle and resilience, speak to truths that still resonate today. By highlighting local legends from Colorado's jazz and hip-hop scenes, we're not just adding beauty to our downtown; we're putting history, culture, and resilience on the wall for all to see," says Molly Gallegos, on-air host for THE DROP 104.7 and KUVO Jazz. "We cannot wait to review submissions and bring this project to life."

The selected artists will design and install the murals. All artwork submissions must be an original design and suitable for viewing by all ages. Artists must be 18 years or older to apply. Each artist chosen will be assigned one musician at random and will receive a 1000-dollar stipend to cover time and materials. Selected artists will also have the opportunity for on-air interviews with KUVO Jazz and THE DROP 104.7.
