#### LICENSE VERIFICATION

#### **TRANSCRIPTS**

Foreign-trained applicants need to arrange for verification of certification by the CGFNS International or have a transcript sent directly to this office from the school;

- Nurses trained and licensed in Canada who meet the educational requirements may be licensed by endorsement provided they have successfully completed the Canadian Registered Nurse Examination (CRNE) in English with a score equivalent to Connecticut's current passing standard (at least 400 in each section of the CRNE exam).
- Nurses who completed the CRNE in French must also pass the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) administered by the Educational Testing Service with a score of at least 550 on the paper-based test or 213 on the computer-based test.
