Role:

Momentous Institute is seeking a Research Specialist with a strong background in qualitative research and/or mixed methods research. The successful candidate will work collaboratively alongside the organization's mental health, education, and innovation and impact teams to understand how and why social emotional health programming helps children to achieve their full potential. We prioritize research — following our students' long-term trajectory and tracking therapy outcomes and parent education. We also conduct evaluation studies of our intensive trainings and innovative approaches to learn, grow and share proven practices and strategies to enhance children's social emotional health.

Responsibilities:

- Works collaboratively with research team members to ensure streamlined research program implementation.
- Entering data collected at Momentous-affiliated or partner research locations using best research practices.
- Consults with co-investigators on appropriate management of participant concerns and research process problems.
- Ensures that projects are executed successfully and completed within time frames to meet research objectives.

- Performs other duties as assigned by Director of Research & Evaluation or the Director of Clinical Research.

Qualifications:

- Some education (Bachelor's Degree preferred) in a relevant field of study, (i.e., psychology or other behavioral science, education).

- Strong verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.
- Solid computer skills necessary, including experience with Microsoft Word and Excel.
- Able to work with clients and colleagues of diverse ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Strong attention to detail, critical thinking, and problem solving are required.
- Bilingual (Spanish/English) preferred.
