

Practicum Clinical Training Opportunities




Momentous Institute

- Momentous Institute has been building and repairing social emotional health for over 100 years. The organization serves 3,000 kids and families each year through mental health programs and education.
- **The clinical training opportunities are housed in the Mental Health Services department.** Through this department, Momentous Institute provides therapy, psychological testing, parent education, and other mental health and social services to families with children.
- Therapy services are primarily offered through three areas of direct service: 1) Indivualized therapy including play, individual, couple and family. 2) Huddle Up, an experiential group therapy program serving youth ages 10 to 15 and their families, and 3) Launch, an early childhood group therapy program that serves children, ages 3-6 years, with major emotional dysregulation.



Clinical Opportunities

- Opportunities available for graduate students pursuing degrees in counseling, psychology, marriage and family therapy, and/or social work.
- Students receive the majority of their direct training in one of our two intensive therapy programs, Huddle Up or Launch, and are also provided opportunities to provide individual and family therapy with children, adolescents and families
- Weekly supervision from a board-approved supervisor, including opportunities for live supervision and co-therapy. Also, the ablility to collaborate with talented and diverse team of clinicians including RPTs, LMFTs, LPs, LCSWs and LPCs.





Requirements & Responsibilities

- Currently enrolled in a Counseling, Psychology, Social Work, or Marriage and Family Therapy graduate program
- Available 20 hours per week for a minimum of 30 weeks
- Must be at least 18 years of age and pass a criminal background check
- Momentous Institute/Salesmanship Club of Dallas cannot accept trainees who are family members of either current employees or Salesmanship Club of Dallas members
