- Ability to attend to children both outdoors and indoors.
- Aid in smooth transitions and a calm consistent schedule for the students.
- Attend training for early childhood practices and engage in refining best practices as determined by Momentous School and NAEYC.
- Attend childcare licensing minimum standard training and maintain classroom expectations based on guidelines and standards.
- Assist in preparing and serving nutritious snacks each day.
- Assist children with breakfast and lunch while engaging in pleasant mealtime conversation.
- Assist children with toileting procedures.
- Check the outdoor nature classroom play area for any irregularities or unsafe objects before allowing children to play.
- Perform other duties as assigned by Supervisor.
